Times tables- Expectations

► By the end of Year 3:

- 3's, 4's and 8 times tables
- 2's, 5's and 10 times tables (Year 2 expectation)

► By the end of Year 4:

- all their times tables up to 12
- The accompanying division facts e.g. if we know 6×6 is 36, then we know 36 divided by 6 is 6

How we learn our times tables

- ▶ Times table songs
- ▶ Rhymes e.g. I ate and I ate till I was sick on the floor, 8×8 is 64.
- ▶ Practice, practice, practice!
