Maths

Year 1

- Solve one step problems involving multiplication and division using concrete and pictorial representations, including arrays.
- Count to and across 100, forwards and backwards, beginning with 0 or 1, or from any given number.
- Count, read and write numbers to 100 in numerals; count in multiples of twos, fives and tens.
- Given a number, identify one more and one less.
- Identify and represent numbers using objects and pictorial representations including.
- The number line, and use the language of: equal to, more than, less than (fewer), most, least.
- Read and write numbers from 1 to 20 in numerals and words.

Year 2

- Count in steps of 2 or 5 from any given number; recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 5x table.
- Solve problems involving multiplication and division using materials, arrays and repeated addition. Calculate and record multiplication statements using x and = signs (compare with repeated addition).
- Using divide and = symbols and comparing equations with multiplication to look for the relationship.
- Count in steps of 2, 3, and 5 from 0, and in tens from any number, forward and backward.
- Compare and order numbers from 0 up to 100; use <, > and = signs.
- Read and write numbers to at least 100 in numerals and in words.
- Use place value and number facts to solve problems.
