Hook: play script "Pirates of the Curry Bean" Auditions for parts

Rational: children will design and make a model stage with characters which can move, operated by different types of cams. The stage will also need lights and moveable curtains.

The theme for the set and the characters will be based on the play Pirates of the Curry Bean

English:

Read a variety of fiction and non-fiction texts on pirates and their history

Information text

- Research information on pirates, using books and selected websites.
- Study the language of information texts, identifying appropriate language for an information text
- Write an information text on pirates

Additional scene for the play: Pirates of the Curry Bean

- Read and study the script of the play Pirates of the Curry Bean
- Identify where the script could be extended
- Study the language and layout of a play script
- Write an additional scene for the play.

Write a biography of a character in the play

- Using the play script infer and invent a backstory for one of the characters in the play
- Write a biography for the character

- Study how cams work by evaluating existing products and designs

- Formulate a step by step guide to make your stage
- Accurately measure, mark out, cut and shape materials and components.

- Accurately apply a range of finishing techniques including decorating your characters and backdrop

- Identify the strengths and areas for development in your product
- Consider the views of others to improve their work.
- Critically evaluate the quality of the design, manufacture and fitness for purpose of your products as you design and make.
- Evaluate their ideas and products against your original design specification.

- Audition for a part in the play
- Learn the lines of your character in the play
- Follow stage directions in the script and additional ones given
- Bring your character to life with tone and expression in your voice
- Use actions to convey feelings
- Work as part of a team

- Sing them on stage
- Work with other pupils to put actions to the songs
